On the other hand, when you are not presenting a paper or participating in the discussion, please mute your microphone (to prevent unwanted acoustic noise).

Presenters, you will be able to share your screen, give a powerpoint presentation, play audio or show a video. Please make sure you know how to do this before you begin your presentation. You can test the system during the first hour each day (15.00 - 16.00 CEST).
