The International Society for Contemporary Legend Research is pleased to announce that the 2021 *Perspectives on Contemporary Legend* 38th International Conference will finally be held from June 28 to July 2. The organizers of the conference (Carme Oriol and Emili Samper), in agreement with the ISCLR Board, have decided that the 2021 meeting will take place **online**.

As usual, the 38th *Perspectives on Contemporary Legend* meeting will be organized as a series of seminars at which the majority of attendees will present papers. Concurrent sessions will be avoided so that all attendants can hear all papers. Presentations will be 20 minutes with an additional 10 minutes for discussion. Proposals for papers on all aspects of contemporary, urban, or modern legend research are sought, as are those on any legend-like tradition (rumour, conspiracy theories, fake news, etc.) that circulate actively at present or have circulated at an earlier historical period.

If we do not receive confirmation we will understand that you withdraw your proposal and do not wish to participate in the conference in its online mode.
